Gifted Summer Camp



Would you like for your gifted child to have stimulating and enriching activities with other gifted children this summer? Would you like your bright child to have the opportunities to exercise her mind, as well as learn skills to improve social skills and

emotional intelligence? Wynns Family Psychology is pleased to offer a novel camp experience combining intellectual, social, and emotional skill-building in one fun camp! Many gifted children have emotional sensitivities, anxiety, or social struggles along with their intellectual/academic needs. This week-long, activity-based camp will provide children with the opportunity to engage in fun, intellectually stimulating activities with peers, while also enhancing their social/emotional functioning. Gifted enrichment PLUS emotional intelligence and social skills enhancement in one fun week!

Topics/activities for this group include:

- Combating perfectionism and self-esteem concerns
- Improving test anxiety or performance pressure
- Social skills building (building deeper friendships, socializing with kids who don't share interests, dealing with awkward/shy moments)
- Dealing with stress and frustration more effectively

Examples of hands-on/creative activities:

- Building a 3-D map of an area out of clay using a topographical map as a guide
- Creating animals from craft supplies based on a given genetic makeup
- Rewriting the ending of a book that students have read
- Writing a historical fiction story that takes place in a time period that they have just learned about
- Creating art that mirrors famous pieces of art in the period of history they are learning about
- Designing an invention that will actually help people and figuring out how they might apply for a patent on it

- Organizing a fundraising event to raise money for a cause and working with all the math (money), writing (advertisements), and other skills that go into it.
